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Wow we had a busy Term 3. The children began the term with much excitement, sharing their Christmas news. This term the children have been working on their number recognition and counting.

We have been looking at "Winter" - the children have been thinking about what clothes you would wear if the weather is cold and wet; the children have been busy exploring our outside area, searching for ice, we have had ice tuff trays where the children have used their large motor skills to break-up the ice using hammers to discover what was hidden in the ice. We made bird feeders which the children hung on the trees in our front garden, and we took part in the Big British Bird Watch 2024.

We have also been looking at "Health and Wellbeing" - the children made a healthy Teddy Bear's picnic, bringing in lots of lovely fresh fruit and vegetables to eat; we have been discussing what are healthy foods and making obstacle courses in the back garden. The children found some giant, dirty, teeth and practiced their teeth brushing skills. Dental care is very important, and our children brush their teeth daily at Lavington Preschool.

The children walked around the village, choosing which houses to deliver a "pocket of hugs" too as our "acts of kindness". They also chose where we would hang some around the village to be found. We will be delivering more of these this term and once again hiding some around the village to be found.

During our last week the children made heart shaped cakes which they decorated and we had pancakes on the last day with the children choosing their favourite toppings.

If your child accidentally takes home clothing which belongs to another child, please can you return this to preschool when you are next in.
