NOTICES:

<u>CLOTHING</u>: Please can we ask that all the children's clothes, shoes, wellington boots, all-in-one waterproofs, lunch boxes, drinking bottles and bags are clearly labelled. If your child accidently takes home clothing which belongs to another child, please can you return this to preschool when you are next in. If your child wears their wellies to school, please can they have shoes to change into.

SNACK: To help us to easily identify which snack belongs to which child, PLEASE can the children have clearly named drinks bottles and clearly named snacks. At Lavington Preschool we promote healthy snacks and lunches, suggestions for snack are: fresh fruit, fresh vegetables, raisins, crackers and cheese or dried fruit (Grapes must be cut in half longways and cherry tomatoes need to be cut into quarters). Water is always the preferred option for their drink as this does not harm the children's teeth. PLEASE REMEMBER WE ARE A NUT FREE SETTING!!

PLEASE NOTE, IF YOU DO NOT SEND A SNACK IN WITH YOUR CHILD, PRE-SCHOOL WILL PROVIDE YOUR CHILD WITH A SNACK AND A FEE OF £1.00 PER DAY WILL BE INVOICED TO YOU.
